SCHOOL CLOSING INFORMATION

In case our school would need to close or impose a 2 hour delay due to inclement weather or poor road conditions, the school will notify everyone on **Wish TV Channel 8, WTHR Channel 13, and via Gradelink.**

- ◆ **Please Note:** Our school does not necessarily follow the Warren Township School System. Also, please note that there is a Trinity Christian School and that if we should have a delay or closing due to the weather, you should look for Trinity Lutheran School.

In the event our school would need to impose a 2 hour delay, Kindergarten - 8th grade would begin class at 10:15am. All morning preschool classes would be cancelled.

Trinity Children's Care will close if the school is closed, but they will open at 7am in the event of a two-hour delay.

2019/2020 Enrollment

Re-enrollment for the 2019/2020 school year has begun. Re-enrollment forms have been sent home with students. In order to ensure your spot at Trinity next year, please turn in your re-enrollment form and registration fee by January 31, 2019. If you re-enroll before January 31, you will receive a \$25 discount on each child's registration fee. Extra forms are available in the school office.

2ND SEMESTER INSTRUCTIONAL FEES

Parents who chose to pay half of the instructional fees at the beginning of the school year, need to pay the other half prior to the start of the 2nd semester (January 14, 2019). Thank you.

1ST SEMESTER & 2ND QUARTER

The 1st semester and the 2nd quarter ends on Friday, January 11, 2019. All past due fees (lunch debt, Children's Care charges, library fines, instructional fees, tuition...) must be paid in full or payment arrangements made. MORNING DROP OFF

We are still having problems with parents dropping off their children at the Commons doors. **Parents are not to drop off (unless your child is going to Children's Care or breakfast) or pick up students at the Commons doors.** The front turnaround is reserved for parents of children attending the infant and toddler children's care. If you arrive after 8:15am, please park your car and walk your children into the building. **Children will not be allowed to enter the building without a parent.** **Access to the back door ends at 8:15am, when the cones go up.**

PRINCIPAL'S CORNER

Did you know? 2017 was the first year in Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod history that our student population in our schools nation-wide shifted from mostly Lutheran to mostly non-Lutheran? It shows the shift that has been made in Lutheran education. Lutheran schools have a missional focus more now than ever. Some of the factors of becoming more missional are income/contribution shifts, shifts in family dynamics, and a need to explain what it means to be a Lutheran Christian and why that is important to us. We see great support in these matters through state-assistance programs, congregation and pastoral interaction, and donor support. Because of the focus on mission, Trinity tries to bring everything to the children and families through the lens of Jesus Christ, our Savior. The work done at Trinity Lutheran School is done by the grace of God, with focus on Christ, with the guidance of the Holy Spirit. Cost per student: \$7,950

Tuition covers about 65% - \$5,167.50
